**Anyone with a new, continuous cough, a high temperature or a change in their sense of smell or taste,** is asked to immediately report these symptoms and book a test at <http://www.nhs.uk/coronavirus>

People who don't have access to the internet, or who have difficulty with the digital portals, can ring the 119 service to book their test.

A drive-through Mobile Testing Unit, run by the Department for Health and Social care, will be operating daily between **11am and 3pm at Dragon Road Car Park, Harrogate HG1 5DB** (Test must be pre-booked as above)

### LOCAL CONTACT TRACING

From Thursday, 5 November, NYCC will be undertaking local contact tracing. If the national Test and Trace system is unable to contact a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 within 24 hours, this will be handed to the local contact tracing team.

Local contact tracing calls will be undertaken by trained staff in the County Council's Customer Resource Centre, using an 01609 number, seven-days-a-week (9am-5pm Mon-Fri and 10.00am-1.00pm Sat-Sun)

Callers from either the local or national Test and Trace services will **never** ask residents to: dial a premium number; make any form of payment; provide bank details; provide passwords or PIN numbers; disclose any personal or medical information; download any software
