- b) To review the ongoing maintenance requirements to PROW: Parish Cllr J Carney is awaiting feedback from NYCC for aggregate for path maintenance. Parish Cllr G Howard has circulated information with the Parish Councillors on the locality funding request for maintenance of PROW in the Parish. This includes for work to lay aggregate, removal of a tree stump from a fallen tree, and equipment hire. £2000 has been requested with an estimated spend of £2660 to spend, therefore the Parish Council would need to provide the difference.
- c) To receive an update on the Memorial Hall refurbishments: Refurbishment works have now started and a small kitchen area is being set up including a fridge, small water boiler and a microwave. Invoices will be submitted to the grant body and VAT is to be claimed back from the HMRC.
